Located in one of Perth's premier office buildings, QV1, Maxim's 950 square-metre offices had to provide areas for work and relaxation with an easy transition between the two. Maxim's principals believe that increased productivity is a natural by-product of office amenity, and that the work environment must continue to stimulate and refresh its staff. For Marshall Kusinski Design Consultants, the challenge was to ensure the ethos of Maxim's energetic professionals was reflected in the habitat: it was to be a stylish yet efficient; professional yet contemporary; sophisticated yet 'edgy' environment with the capacity to nurture professional growth.

Schiavello's Admet workstation panels are kept low and translucent glazed panels maximise the use of natural light. The Elitone Desking System helps streamline the space to avoid the perception of clutter in a transparent environment. The use of the Elitone system contributes to a 'light' feeling of the worktops located against the perimeter glazing. Klöber Metric and Cresta seating and Elitone was used throughout with various levels

of finishes subtly defining hierarchy – for example, veneer worktops to Principal and Senior offices and laminate worktops to Junior offices. Schiavello's custom workstation bookcases, mobile powder-coated MDF pedestals in corporate livery and screen hung shelves to workstations accommodate a substantial amount of storage. Schiavello's workstation solutions are at once contemporary and timeless," says Kevin Stewart of Maxim.
